Precis

Paul Brady is a chartered civil engineer with 27 years experience in both the design and construction of heavy civil works. This includes 15 years specifically on marine construction projects.

Following graduation with honours, Paul spent 3 years working as a design engineer with involvement in a variety of marine and bridge projects, firstly in Australia and later in the UK. He then spent the next 15 years with Contractors on wharves, jetties, bridges, viaducts and heavy civil works; holding positions including Project Manager, Construction Manager or Engineering/Technical Manager. Projects were in Australia, the UK, Thailand, Malaysia and Singapore as well as several countries in the Middle East.

In 2005 Paul took over as Managing Director of Smithbridge Australia Pty Ltd, a technically competent Brisbane-based Contractor with specialist skills in marine and bridge works. Under his 5 year stewardship the company developed into a leading marine infrastructure specialist, acquiring a comprehensive list of specialist equipment in the process.

In late 2010 he started a process of separation from the Smithbridge Group, preferring to concentrate on remaining an independent specialist marine infrastructure provider. This goal has been achieved in a relatively short period of time, with almost \$50M of challenging projects in Brisbane and nationally already successfully completed through Brady Marine & Civil.

In parallel to this Paul has also formalised a partnership in Malaysia with JEKS Engineering Sdn Bhd a specialist in precast concrete supply and erection. Their business JEKS BMC Sdn Bhd targets similar marine infrastructure projects in SE Asia from a Kuala Lumpur base, with two significant projects already completed.
